Being spun a yarn?

The measure of quality for a traditional socket mop is the 'yarn weight'. Essentially this measures the amount of yarn used to make the head of the mop – the heavier the yarn weight, the more durable the mop. The CHSA Accreditation Scheme logo is your guarantee that you're getting the yarn weight you've paid for – protecting you from rogue-traders who deliberately sell underweight mops.



Getting ripped off?

Over the last few years there has been a dramatic increase in soft tissue products being sold in unmarked and inaccurately labelled packs. Often misleadingly presented as 'value' purchases, these packs can hide under-sized, loosely-bound rolls which short-change consumers.
